St John's Church of England School is committed to upholding the rights of the child. In so doing, we understand the importance of helping all children know about the country in which they live, its history and culture. Additionally, as our school is made up of many communities we are committed to ensuring tolerance and respect for others, basic British values.

Furthermore our school recognises our responsibility to prepare children for life in modern Britain and is committed to ensuring that the fundamental British values are promoted consistently, discussed and lived out through the ethos and work of our school.

We want to ensure that our children are not subjected to intimidation or radicalization by those wishing to unduly, or illegally, influence them.

As our school is an inclusive one, it accepts admissions from all those entitled to an education under British law, including pupils of all faiths or none. It follows the policies outlined by the Governing Body regarding equal opportunities, which guarantee that there will be no discrimination against any individual or group, regardless of faith, ethnicity gender, etc.

The Government emphasises that schools are required to ensure that key British Values are taught in all UK schools. It set out its definition of British Values in the Prevent Strategy.
